Because Love Feast is a church community event, I encourage as many of you as are able to participate in the service at 6:00 p.m., our usual meeting time, so that we are all worshiping, washing feet and taking communion around the same time.

The service will include meditations and music. Time will be provided for you to eat a light snack and to wash the hands and feet of those in your household. You may want to have a basin with water and a towel prepared before you begin the service. Some folks prefer to use pre-moistened wipes. We recommend that you gather in advance some items to use for communion: a cracker or piece of bread and a beverage of juice, water, or soda.

Join us as we draw together spiritually, but from a distance for this revised version of a treasured tradition in the Church of the Brethren.
